“Where”?	But YHWH God called to the man, and said to him, <u>"Where are you?"</u>	Then YHWH said to Cain, <u>"Where is your brother Abel?"</u>
Pronoun “I” (Hebrew, ‘anokhiy, only these two places in Genesis until 7.4)	He said, "I heard the sound of you in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself [<u>‘anokhiy</u>]."	He said, "I do not know; am I [<u>‘anokhiy</u>] my brother's keeper?"
YHWH’s accusation	He said, "Who told you that you were naked? <u>Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?"</u>	And YHWH said, " <u>What have you done?</u> Listen; your brother's blood is crying out to me from the ground!
Curse related to the ‘adamah	<u>cursed is the ground because of you;</u> in toil you shall eat of it all the days of your life...	And now <u>you are cursed from the ground,</u> which has opened its mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand. you will be a fugitive and a wanderer on the earth."
Cursed outcome in relation to earth and food	<u>thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you;</u> and you shall eat the plants of the field. By the sweat of your face you shall eat bread until you return to the ground, for out of it you were taken; you are dust, and to dust you shall return."	When you till the ground, it will <u>no longer yield to you its strength...</u>
Banishment/exile	therefore YHWH God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from which he was taken. He <u>drove out the man...</u>	you will be a fugitive and a wanderer on the earth." Today you <u>have driven me away</u> from the soil, and I shall be hidden from your face; I shall be a fugitive and a wanderer on the earth...
East of Eden	at the <u>east of the garden of Eden</u> he placed the cherubim, and a sword flaming and turning to guard the way to the tree of life.	Then Cain went away from the presence of YHWH, and settled in the land of Nod, <u>east of Eden.</u>
