- ) "Original sin": Hebrew, chattat, for "sin," is first mentioned at Genesis 4.7, from YHWH to Cain.
- *Male superiority or female inferiority*
- ) Women as "temptress" to men on the one hand or "helper" to men on the other
- ) The snake as "the devil"

## What the Garden of Eden story IS about:

- Humanity's relationship with God, the earth and each other
- A counterstory to Babylon's Enuma Elish: humans are meant by God to live on the earth, not in imperial cities grounded in surplus agriculture
- A sly satire on monarchy and the temptation of "royal wisdom"
- An explanation of the relationship between patriarchy and agriculture in the world lived by the first audience of Genesis

## Tensions within the Garden of Eden

HOME: in the "garden" or outside?

FOOD: provided by God (gathering fruit) or by human effort (work in the field)

**BUILDING:** God building humans or humans building cities, etc.

LANGUAGE: a tool for honest sharing of inner thoughts and feelings or a tool for power over others

TIME: focus on the present or on the future?
