

The four “living creatures” (Hebrew, *chayyot*; Greek, *zōon*) in Ezekiel and Revelation

Ezekiel 1.6-10ff (echoed at 10.15ff)	Revelation 4.6ff (echoed at 5.6ff, etc.)
four faces, <u>four</u> wings	Six wings [like the seraphs at Isaiah 6.2]
human hands	Full of eyes, inside, outside, all around
respectively, faces of: a human a lion an ox an eagle	First “like a lion” Second “like an ox” Third, “like a human face” Fourth, “like a flying eagle”
[Ezekiel situates them among interlocking “wheels”]	[John situates them around the throne and among the elders]
