<i>Huios</i> (son)	1.13, 16, 31, 32, 35, 36, 57; 2.7
<i>Teknon</i> (child)	1.7, 17; 2.48

## Scripture echoes in Luke 2

VERSE	ECHO
<b>law</b>	
2.22	“law of Moses” Leviticus 12 = purification sacrifice
2.23	Exodus 12.12-13: firstborn = holy
2.24	Leviticus 12.6-8: bird sacrifice
2.25	Leviticus 15.31 LXX, <i>eulabes</i> for “devout” Isaiah (various refs to “consolation”/“comfort” of Israel)
2.27	“customary under the law”
<b>prophets</b>	
2.30	Isaiah 52.7 LXX, <i>sōterios</i> for “salvation”
2.31	Isaiah 52.10 LXX, “all peoples/nations”
2.32	Isaiah 52.10+49.6+ 42.6: “light for revelation to the nations” Isaiah 46.13: glory to your people Israel
2.34	Isaiah 28.16 LXX, <i>keitai</i> for “laying” a foundation/stone Isaiah 7.14 + 8.14, 18 LXX: “a sign that will be opposed”
2.36	Prophet Anna
2.38	Isaiah 63.4: time for “redemption of Israel”
<b>wisdom</b>	
2.40	Wisdom
2.47	<i>Sunesis</i> for “understanding”: “especially in wisdom literature...” (Bovin 112) Proverbs 4.1-9: father teaches son to seek wisdom
2.50	<i>Sunekan</i> for “understanding”
2.52	Increased in wisdom
