1.35	The angel said to her, "The <b>Holy Spirit</b> will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; he will be called Son of God.
1.41	When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the child leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the <b>Holy Spirit</b>
1.67	Then his father Zechariah was filled with the <b>Holy Spirit</b> and spoke this prophecy
2.25- 26	Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon; this man was righteous and devout, looking forward to the consolation of Israel, and the <b>Holy Spirit</b> rested on him. It had been revealed to him by the <b>Holy Spirit</b> that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Messiah.
3.16	John answered all of them by saying, "I baptize you with water; but one who is more powerful than I is coming; I am not worthy to untie the thong of his sandals. He will baptize you with the <b>Holy Spirit</b> and fire.
3.21-22	Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, the heaven was opened, and the <b>Holy Spirit</b> descended upon him in bodily form like a dove.
4.1-2	Jesus, full of the <b>Holy Spirit</b> , returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness, where for forty days he was tempted by the devil.
10.21	At that same hour Jesus rejoiced in the <b>Holy Spirit</b> and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will.
11.13	you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the <b>Holy Spirit</b> to those who ask him!
12.10	And everyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven; but whoever blasphemes against the <b>Holy Spirit</b> will not be forgiven.
12.11-12	When they bring you before the synagogues, the rulers, and the authorities, do not worry about how you are to defend yourselves or what you are to say; for the <b>Holy Spirit</b> will teach you at that very hour what you ought to say."
