

“Rescue” (Hebrew, *ntsl*, in hifal stem) in Samuel

1 SAMUEL

4.8	Woe to us [Philistines]! Who can rescue us from the power of these mighty gods? These are the gods who struck the Egyptians with every sort of plague in the wilderness.
7.3	Then Samuel said to all the house of Israel, "If you are returning to YHWH with all your heart, then put away the foreign gods and the Astartes from among you. Direct your heart to YHWH, and serve him only, and he will rescue you out of the hand of the Philistines."
7.14	The towns that the Philistines had taken from Israel were restored to Israel, from Ekron to Gath; and Israel rescued their territory from the hand of the Philistines. There was peace also between Israel and the Amorites.
10.18	[Samuel] said to them, "Thus says YHWH, the God of Israel, 'I brought up Israel out of Egypt, and I rescued you from the hand of the Egyptians and from the hand of all the kingdoms that were oppressing you.'"
12.10	[part of Samuel's recital] Then [the Israelites] cried to YHWH, and said, 'We have sinned, because we have forsaken YHWH, and have served the Baals and the Astartes; but now rescue us out of the hand of our enemies, and we will serve you.'
12.11	And YHWH sent Jerubbaal and Barak, and Jephthah, and Samson, and rescued you out of the hand of your enemies on every side; and you lived in safety.
12.20c-21	[Samuel said]...serve YHWH with all your heart; and do not turn aside after useless things that cannot profit or rescue , for they are useless.
14.48	[Saul] did valiantly, and struck down the Amalekites, and rescued Israel out of the hands of those who plundered them.
17.35, 37	I [David] went after it and struck it down, rescuing the lamb from its mouth; and if it turned against me, I would catch it by the jaw, strike it down, and kill it...David said, "YHWH, who saved me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, will rescue me from the hand of this Philistine."
26.24	[David to Saul] "As your life was precious today in my sight, so may my life be precious in the sight of YHWH, and may he rescue me from all tribulation."
30.8	David inquired of YHWH, "Shall I pursue this band? Shall I overtake them?" He answered him, "Pursue; for you shall surely overtake and shall surely rescue ."
30.18	David recovered all that the Amalekites had taken; and David rescued his two wives.

2 SAMUEL

12.7	Nathan said to David, "You are the man! Thus says YHWH, the God of Israel: I anointed you king over Israel, and I rescued you from the hand of Saul..."
14.6	[The woman of Tekoa to David] Your servant had two sons, and they fought with one another in the field; there was no one to rescue them, and one struck the other and killed him.
14.16	[the woman of Tekoa to David] For the king will hear and deliver his servant from the hand of the man who would cut both me and my son off from the heritage of God.'
19.10	All the people were disputing throughout all the tribes of Israel, saying, "The king rescued us from the hand of our enemies, and saved us from the hand of the Philistines; and now he has fled out of the land because of Absalom."
22.1, 18	David spoke to YHWH the words of this song on the day when YHWH rescued him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul..."He rescued me from my strong enemy, from those who hated me; for they were too mighty for me."
22.49	[David speaking] [God], who brought me out from my enemies; you exalted me above my adversaries, you rescued me from the violent.
23.12	But [David] took his stand in the middle of the plot, defended it, and killed the Philistines; and YHWH brought about a great rescue .
