

“finding” (Hebrew, *mts’*) in 1 Sam 9.3-10.16

(12/39 uses of this verb in 1 Samuel are in this section)

9.4	He passed through the hill country of Ephraim and passed through the land of Shalishah, but they did not find them. And they passed through the land of Shaalim, but they were not there. Then he passed through the land of Benjamin, but they did not find them.
9.8	The boy answered Saul again, "Here, I found with me a quarter shekel of silver
9.11	As they went up the hill to the town, they found some girls coming out to draw water
9.13	As soon as you enter the town, you will find him, before he goes up to the shrine to eat. For the people will not eat until he comes, since he must bless the sacrifice; afterward those eat who are invited. Now go up, for you will find him immediately.
9.20	As for your donkeys that were lost three days ago, give no further thought to them, for they have been found .
10.2	When you depart from me today you will meet two men by Rachel's tomb in the territory of Benjamin at Zelzah; they will say to you, 'The donkeys that you went to seek are found
10.3	Then you shall go on from there further and come to the oak of Tabor; three men going up to God at Bethel will find you there
10.7	Now when these signs find you, do whatever you see fit to do, for God is with you.
10.16	Saul said to his uncle, "He told us that the donkeys had been found ." But about the matter of the kingship, of which Samuel had spoken, he did not tell him anything.
