

## **“Forever and ever” (Greek, *aiōnas tōn aiōnon*) in Revelation**

---

- 1.6: to him be glory and dominion forever and ever.
- 1.18: I am alive forever and ever
- 4.9, 10: the one who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever
- 5.13: To the one seated on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!
- 7.12: Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might be to our God forever and ever!
- 10.6: him who lives forever and ever
- 11.15: The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign forever and ever.
- 15.7: God, who lives forever and ever
- 19.3: The smoke goes up from [Babylon] forever and ever.
- 22.5: they will reign forever and ever

## **Voice from heaven/sky (Greek, *phōnē ek tou ouranou*) in Revelation**

---

- 10.4 but I heard a voice from heaven saying, "Seal up what the seven thunders have said, and do not write it down."
- 11.12 they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here!"
- 14.2-3a I heard a voice from heaven like the sound of many waters [1.15; 19.6] and like the sound of loud thunder [4.5; 6.1; 8.5; 10.3, 4; 11.19; 16.18; 19.6]; the voice I heard was like the sound of harpists playing on their harps [5.8; 15.2; negatively, 18.22], and they sing a new song [5.9]...
- 14.13 And I heard a voice from heaven saying, "Write this: Blessed are the dead who from now on die in the Lord."
- 18.4 I heard another voice from heaven saying, "Come out of her, my people, so that you do not take part in her sins..."
