## "Coming soon" [erchomai tachus] in Revelation

2.16: Repent then. If not, <u>I will come to you soon</u> and make war against them with the sword of my mouth.

3.11: <u>I am coming soon</u>; hold fast to what you have, so that no one may seize your crown.

11.14: The second woe has passed. The third woe is coming very soon.

22.7: "See, <u>I am coming soon!</u> Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book."

22.12: "See, <u>I am coming soon</u>; my reward is with me, to repay according to everyone's work.

22.20: The one who testifies to these things says, "Yes, I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!

## Wrath [orgē] in Revelation

6.16-17: "Fall on us and hide us from the face of the one seated on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb; for the great day of their wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

11.18: The nations raged, but <u>your wrath has come</u>, and the time for judging the dead, <u>for rewarding your servants</u>, the prophets and saints and all who fear your name, both small and great, and for destroying those who destroy the earth."

14.10: [Those who worship the beast and its image] will also drink the wine of God's wrath, poured unmixed into the cup of his anger, and they will be tormented with fire and sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.

16.19: The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. God remembered great Babylon and gave her the wine-cup of the fury of his wrath.

19.15: From his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, and he will rule them with a rod of iron; he will tread the wine press of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty.
