

“Making” [Hebrew, `sh] in 1 Samuel 12

12.6	Samuel said to the people, "YHWH is witness, who made Moses and Aaron and brought your ancestors up out of the land of Egypt.
12.7:	Now therefore take your stand , so that I may enter into judgment with you before YHWH, and I will declare to you <i>all the justice [Heb, kal-tsideqoth, only 26.23 elsewhere in Samuel].</i> YHWH that he made for you and for your ancestors.
12.16	Now therefore take your stand and <i>see this great thing that YHWH will make before your eyes.</i>
12.17	I will call upon YHWH, that he may send thunder and rain; and you shall know and see that <i>the wickedness that you have made in the sight of YHWH is great in demanding a king for yourselves.</i> "
12.20	And Samuel said to the people, "Do not be afraid; <i>you have made all this evil</i> , yet do not turn aside from following YHWH, but serve YHWH with all your heart
12.22	For YHWH will not cast away his people, for his great name's sake, because <i>it has pleased YHWH to make you a people for himself.</i>
