"Making" [Hebrew, `*sh*] in 1 Samuel 12

12.6	Samuel said to the people, "YHWH is witness, who made Moses and Aa- ron and brought your ancestors up out of the land of Egypt.
12.7:	Now therefore take your stand , so that I may enter into judgment with you before YHWH, and I will declare to you all the justice [Heb, <i>kal-tsideqoth</i> , only 26.23 elsewhere in Samuel]. YHWH that he made for you and for your ancestors.
12.16	Now therefore take your stand and see this great thing that YHWH will make before your eyes.
12.17	I will call upon YHWH, that he may send thunder and rain; and you shall know and see that the wickedness that you have made in the sight of YHWH is great in demanding a king for yourselves."
12.20	And Samuel said to the people, "Do not be afraid; you have made all this evil, yet do not turn aside from following YHWH, but serve YHWH with all your heart
12.22	For YHWH will not cast away his people, for his great name's sake, be- cause it has pleased YHWH to make you a people for himself.
