

“To be found” [Hebrew, *mts'*, nifal] in 1 Samuel 13.15-22

13.15	Saul counted the people who were found with him , about six hundred men.
13.16	Saul, his son Jonathan, and the people who were found with them stayed in Geba of Benjamin
13.19	Now there was no smith to be found throughout all the land of Israel
13.22	So on the day of the battle neither sword nor spear was to be found in the possession of any of the people to be found with Saul and Jonathan
