## Issues in the story of Genesis 9.20-27

- 1. What is the relationship between this story and the Garden (Genesis 2-3) and Cain/Abel stories (Genesis 4)?
- 2. What is the relationship between this story and the "Table of Nations" (Genesis 10) and "Tower of Babel" story (Genesis 11)?
- 3. What is the relationship between this story and the story of Lot and his daughters (i.e., the sexually suspicious origin of some of Israel's ancient "enemies", Gen 19.30-38)?
- 4. What exactly did Noah do and did Ham "see"?
- 5. Why is the curse on Canaan if it was Ham who saw his father's "nakedness"?
- 6. What does this story reveal about the outcome of the Flood in terms of human evil/violence and relationship with God, nonhumans, and the earth itself?
- 7. What is the power of a human "curse" in relation to YHWH's curse (in the Garden and of Cain)?
- 8. How has the "curse of Ham" become a primary source of justification for racism and slavery of "black" people?
