

Names for the body of water in Galilee in the Bible

AS "SEA OF GALILEE" (AS PART OF SYMBOLIC TRADITION OF "THE SEA")	
Mark 1.16	As Jesus passed along the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the sea--for they were fishermen.
Matthew 4.18	As he walked by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea--for they were fishermen.
Mark 7.31	Then he returned from the region of Tyre, and went by way of Sidon towards the Sea of Galilee, in the region of the Decapolis.
Matthew 15.29	After Jesus had left that place, he passed along the Sea of Galilee, and he went up the mountain, where he sat down.
AS "SEA OF TIBERIAS" (IN HONOR OF THE EMPEROR AS PATRON)	
John 6.1	After this Jesus went to the other side of the Sea of Galilee, also called the Sea of Tiberias.
John 21.1	After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias
AS "LAKE OF" OR "LAND OF" GENNESARET (A TOWN ON THE SHORE)	
Luke 5.1	Once while Jesus was standing beside the lake of Gennesaret, and the crowd was pressing in on him to hear the word of God
Mark 6.53	When they had crossed over, they came to land at Gennesaret and moored the boat
Matthew 14.34	When they had crossed over, they came to land at Gennesaret.
AS "SEA OF 'CHINNERETH" (PERHAPS FROM HEBREW, KINNERET, "HARP")	
Numbers 34.11	from Shepham to Riblah on the east side of Ain; and the boundary shall go down, and reach the eastern slope of the sea of Chinnereth;
Joshua 13.27	in the valley Beth-haram, Beth-nimrah, Succoth, and Zaphon, the rest of the kingdom of King Sihon of Heshbon, the Jordan and its banks, as far as the lower end of the Sea of Chinnereth, eastward beyond the Jordan.
Deuteronomy 3.17	with the Jordan and its banks, from Chinnereth down to the sea of the Arabah, the Dead Sea, with the lower slopes of Pisgah on the east.
