Great crowds come to hear Jesus and to be healed by him

5.15-17

But now more than ever the word about Jesus spread abroad; great crowds [ochlois polloi] would gather to hear him and to be cured [therapeuesthai] of their diseases [astheneiōn].

[16 But he would withdraw to deserted places and pray.]

17 One day, while he was teaching, Pharisees and teachers of the law were sitting near by (they had come from every village of Galilee and Judea and from Jerusalem); and the power of the Lord was with him to heal [iasthai].

6.17-19

He came down with them and stood on a level place, with a great crowd [ochlos polus] of his disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea, Jerusalem, and the coast of Tyre and Sidon.

18 They had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases [nosōn]; and those who were troubled with unclean spirits were cured [etherapeuonto].

19 And all in the crowd were trying to touch him, for power came out from him and healed [iato] all of them.
