## Hebrew Scripture echoes in Revelation 13

13.1	Beast rising out of the sea	Daniel 7.3 and four great beasts came up out of the sea, different from one another.
13.1	Ten horns	Daniel 7.7 After this I saw in the visions by night a fourth beast, terrifying and dreadful and exceedingly strong. It had great iron teeth and was devouring, breaking in pieces, and stamping what was left with its feet. It was different from all the beasts that preceded it, and it had ten horns.
13.2	Beast <b>like a leop-</b> <b>ard</b>	Daniel 7.6 After this, as I watched, another appeared, like a leopard. The beast had four wings of a bird on its back and four heads; and dominion was given to it.
13.2	Feet <b>like a bear</b>	Daniel 7.5 Another beast appeared, a second one, that looked like a bear. It was raised up on one side, had three tusks in its mouth among its teeth and was told, "Arise, devour many bodies!"
13.2	Lion's mouth	Daniel 7.4 The first was like a lion and had eagles' wings. Then, as I watched, its wings were plucked off, and it was lifted up from the ground and made to stand on two feet like a human being; and a human mind was given to it.
13.3	In amazement <b>the whole earth</b> fol- lowed the beast.	Daniel 7.23 This is what he said: "As for the fourth beast, there shall be a fourth kingdom on earth that shall be different from all the other kingdoms; it shall devour the whole earth, and trample it down, and break it to pieces.
