## Traditional scholarly view of relationship between Matthew and Luke

- 1. Gospel of Mark is a primary source for both Matthew and Luke
- 2. <u>Elements found in BOTH</u> Matthew and Luke but NOT in Mark are called "Q," from the German, Quelle, meaning "source."
- 3. Each gospel also has it's own, unique elements

## **Challenges to this view**

- 1. No such manuscript of "Q" or anything like it has ever been found.
- 2. How do we know that either the author of Luke or Matthew didn't have the other's work to consult?
- 3. Is there any basis for determining which of Luke or Matthew was written first?
