| <p>Revelation 14.8b She has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication [Gk, <i>porneia</i>]</p> | <p>Jeremiah 51.7 Babylon was a golden cup in YHWH's hand, making all the earth drunken; the nations drank of her wine, and so the nations went mad.</p> <p>Ezekiel 16.28-30 You [Jerusalem] played the whore [Gk, <i>porneia</i>] with the Assyrians, because you were insatiable; you played the whore [Gk, <i>porneia</i>] with them, and still you were not satisfied. You multiplied your whoring [Gk, <i>porneia</i>] with Chaldea, the land of merchants; and even with this you were not satisfied. How sick is your heart, says YHWH GOD, that you did all these things [see also Ezekiel 23]</p> |
| <p>14.10 they will also drink the wine of God's wrath</p> | <p>Jeremiah 25.15 For thus YHWH, the God of Israel, said to me: Take from my hand this cup of the wine of wrath, and make all the nations to whom I send you drink it.</p> |
| <p>Anger [Gk, <i>orgē</i>] and wrath [Gk, <i>thumou</i>]</p> | <p>Jeremiah 30.23-24 Look, the storm of YHWH! Wrath [Gk, <i>thumou</i>] has gone forth, a whirling tempest; it will burst upon the head of the wicked. The fierce anger [Gk, <i>orgē</i>] of YHWH will not turn back until he has executed and accomplished the intents of his mind. In the latter days you will understand this.</p> <p>Ezekiel 22.20 As one gathers silver, bronze, iron, lead, and tin into a smelter, to blow the fire upon them in order to melt them; so I will gather you in my anger [Gk, <i>orgē</i>] and in my wrath [Gk, <i>thumou</i>], and I will put you in and melt you.</p> |
| <p>Tormented with fire and sulfur</p> | <p>Ezekiel 38.22 With pestilence and bloodshed I will enter into judgment with [Gog]; and I will pour down torrential rains and hailstones, fire and sulfur, upon him and his troops and the many peoples that are with him. So I will display my greatness and my holiness and make myself known in the eyes of many nations. Then they shall know that I am YHWH.</p> |
