Echoes of Psalm 96 in Revelation

O sing to YHWH a new song [Rev 14.3]; sing to YHWH, all the earth.

Sing to YHWH, bless his name [5.12]; tell [LXX, euangelizō, cf. Rev 14.6] of his salvation [Rev 7.10; 12.10; 19.1] from day to day.

Declare his glory [Rev 16; 4.9; 7.12; 11.13; 14.7; 15.4; 16.9; 19.1; 21.11, 23] among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples.

For great is YHWH, and **greatly to be praised [Rev 19.5]**; **he is to be feared above all gods [Rev 14.7]**.

For all the gods of the peoples are idols, but **YHWH made the heavens [Rev 4.11; 10.6]**.

Honor [Rev 4.9, 11; 5.12, 13] and majesty are before him; strength [Rev 5.12] and beauty are in his sanctuary.

Ascribe to YHWH, O families of the peoples, ascribe to YHWH glory and strength.

Ascribe to YHWH the glory due his name; bring an offering, and come into his courts.

Worship YHWH in holy splendor; tremble before him, all the earth.

Say among the nations, "YHWH is king! [Rev 15.3; 17.14; 19.16] The world is firmly established; it shall never be moved. He will judge the peoples with equity." [Rev 11.18; 14.7; 15.4; 16.5; 17.1; 18.10, 20; 19.2; 20.12-13]

Let the heavens be glad [Rev 12.12, 18.20] and let the earth rejoice [Rev 19.7]; let the sea roar, and all that fills it [Rev 5.13];

Let the field exult, and everything in it. Then shall all the trees of the forest sing for joy

before YHWH; for he is coming [Rev 16.15], for he is coming to judge the earth [Rev 14.7; 18.10, 20]. He will judge the world with justice, and the peoples with his truth [Rev 16.7].
