

“Forever and ever” or “age upon age” (Greek, *aiōnas tōn aiōniōn*) in Revelation

to him be glory and dominion forever and ever. (1.6)

I [the Lamb] am alive forever and ever (1.18)

the one who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever (again, 4.10)

To the one seated on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever! (5.13)

Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might be to our God forever and ever! (7.12)

[The One] who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and what is in it, the earth and what is in it, and the sea and what is in it (10.6)

[Our Lord and Messiah] will reign forever and ever. (11.15)

And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever. (14.11)

God, who lives forever and ever (15.7)

The smoke goes up from [Babylon] forever and ever. (19.3)

[The devil, the beast and the false prophet] will be tormented day and night forever and ever. (20.10)

[God’s servants] will reign forever and ever. (22.5)
