

## Hebrew Scripture echoes in Revelation 14

14.1	<b>Mt. Zion</b>	<p>Joel 2.32 Then everyone who calls on the name of YHWH shall be saved; for in <b>Mount Zion</b> and in Jerusalem there shall be those who escape</p> <p>Isaiah 10.12 When YHWH has finished all his work on <b>Mount Zion</b> and on Jerusalem, he will punish the arrogant boasting of the king of Assyria and his haughty pride.</p>
14.2	And I heard a voice from heaven like the <b>sound of many waters and like the sound of loud thunder</b>	<p>Psalms 93.4 More majestic than the <b>thunders of mighty waters</b>, more majestic than the waves of the sea, majestic on high is YHWH!</p>
14.3	<b>“they sing a new song”</b>	<p>Psalms 98.1 <b>O sing to YHWH a new song</b>, for he has done marvelous things. His right hand and his holy arm have gotten him victory.</p> <p>Isaiah 42.10 <b>Sing to YHWH a new song</b>, his praise from the end of the earth! Let the sea roar and all that fills it, the coastlands and their inhabitants.</p>
14.4	<b>As first fruits for God</b>	<p>Leviticus 23.10 When you enter the land that I am giving you and you reap its harvest, <b>you shall bring the sheaf of the first fruits of your harvest to the priest.</b></p> <p>Proverbs 9.3 Honor YHWH with your substance and with the <b>first fruits of all your produce</b></p> <p>Jeremiah 2.2-3a Go and proclaim in the hearing of Jerusalem, Thus says YHWH <b>I remember the devotion of your youth, your love as a bride</b>, how you followed me in the wilderness, in a land not sown. <b>Israel was holy to YHWH, the first fruits of his harvest.</b></p>
14.5	and <b>in their mouth no lie was found</b>	<p>Zephaniah 3.13 <b>the remnant of Israel</b>; they shall do no wrong and <b>utter no lies, nor shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouths.</b></p>
14.6	with <b>an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth</b> --to every nation and tribe and language and people.	<p>Isaiah 40.9 Get you up to a high mountain, O Zion, herald of <b>good news</b>; lift up your voice with strength, O Jerusalem, herald of <b>good news</b>, lift it up, do not fear; say to the cities of Judah, "Here is your God!"</p>

14.7	worship <b>him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water.</b>	Exodus 20.11 For in six days <b>YHWH made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them</b>
14.8	<b>She has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath</b> of her fornication."	Jeremiah 51.7 <b>Babylon was a golden cup in the Lord's hand, making all the earth drunken; the nations drank of her wine,</b> and so the nations went mad.
14.8	<b>"Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great!"</b>	Isaiah 21.9 <b>"Fallen, fallen is Babylon;</b> and all the images of her gods lie shattered on the ground."
14.10	they will also <b>drink the wine of God's wrath,</b> poured unmixed into the cup of his anger	Deuteronomy 32.32 Their vine comes from the vinestock of Sodom, from the vineyards of Gomorrah; <b>their grapes are grapes of poison, their clusters are bitter</b>
14.10	they will be <b>tormented with fire and sulfur</b>	Genesis 19.24 Then YHWH rained on Sodom and Gomorrah <b>sulfur and fire from YHWH</b> out of heaven Psalm 11.6 <b>On the wicked he will rain coals of fire and sulfur;</b> a scorching wind shall be the portion of their cup.
14.11	And the <b>smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever.</b>	Genesis 19.28 and he looked down toward Sodom and Gomorrah and toward all the land of the Plain and saw <b>the smoke of the land going up like the smoke of a furnace.</b>
14.13	<b>"Yes," says the Spirit, "they will rest from their labors, for their deeds follow them."</b>	Daniel 12.13 <b>But you, go your way, and rest; you shall rise for your reward at the end of the days.</b>
14.15	<b>"Use your sickle and reap, for the hour to reap has come, because the harvest of the earth is fully ripe."</b>	Joel 3.13 <b>Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Go in, tread, for the wine press is full.</b> The vats overflow, for their wickedness is great.
14.18	<b>"Use your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for its grapes are ripe."</b>	[as above]
14.19	<b>So the angel swung his sickle over the earth and gathered the vintage of the earth, and he threw it into the great wine press of the wrath of</b>	Isaiah 63.3 <b>I have trodden the wine press alone,</b> and from the peoples no one was with me; <b>I trod them in my anger and trampled them in my wrath;</b> their juice spattered on my garments, and stained all my robes.
