9 And Abram journeyed on by stages toward the Negeb.

10 <u>Now there was a famine in the</u> <u>land.</u> So Abram went down to Egypt to reside there as an alien, for the famine was severe in the land.

13.1-4

So Abram went up from Egypt, he and his woman, and all that he had, and Lot with him, into the Negeb.
2 Now Abram was very rich in live-stock, in silver, and in gold.
3 He journeyed on by stages from the Negeb as far as Bethel, to the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethel and Ai, 4 to the place where he had made an altar at the first; and there Abram called on the name of YHWH.
