YHWH's "regret" (Hebrew, nchm, nifal stem) in the Bible [GREEN = repent/change mind; RED = NOT repent/change mind

Gen 6.6-7	And YHWH was sorry that he had made humankind on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart. So YHWH said, "I will blot out from the earth the human beings I have createdpeople together with animals and creeping things and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them."
Ex 32.14	And YHWH changed his mind about the disaster that he planned to bring on his people.
Num 23.19	God is not a human being, that he should lie, or a mortal, that he should change his mind. Has he promised, and will he not do it? Has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?
1 Sam 15.11	"I regret that I made Saul king, for he has turned back from following me, and has not carried out my commands."
1 Sam 15.29	"Moreover the Glory of Israel will not recant or change his mind; for he is not a mortal, that he should change his mind."
1 Sam 15.35	And YHWH was sorry that he had made Saul king over Israel.
Jer 4.28	I have spoken, I have purposed; I have not relented nor will I turn back.
Jer 15.6	You have rejected me, says YHWH, you are going backward; so I have stretched out my hand against you and destroyed you I am weary of relenting.
Jer 18.8 (and 18.10)	if that nation, concerning which I have spoken, turns from its evil, I will change my mind about the disaster that I intended to bring on it.
Jer 26.3 (and 26.13, 19)	It may be that they will listen, all of them, and will turn from their evil way, that I may change my mind about the disaster that I intend to bring on them because of their evil doings.
Joel 2.13- 14	Return to YHWH, your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love, and relents from punishing. Who knows whether he will not turn and relent , and leave a blessing behind him, a grain offering and a drink offering for YHWH, your God?
Amos 7.3 (and 7.6)	YHWH relented concerning this; "It shall not be," said YHWH.
Jonah 3.10	When God saw what they did, how they turned from their evil ways, God changed his mind about the calamity that he had said he would bring upon them; and he did not do it.
Zech 8.14	For thus says YHWH of hosts: Just as I purposed to bring disaster upon you, when your ancestors provoked me to wrath, and I did not relent, says YHWH of hosts,
Ps 110.4	YHWH has sworn and will not change his mind , "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."
