At the cross	15.40-41: There were also women looking on from a distance; among them were Mary Magdalene , and Mary the mother of James the younger and of Joses , and Salome . These used to follow him and provided for him when he was in Galilee; and there were many other women who had come up with him to Jerusalem.	27.55-56: Many women were also there, looking on from a distance; they had followed Jesus from Galilee and had provided for him. Among them were Mary Magdalene , and Mary the mother of James and Joseph , and the mother of the sons of Zebedee .	23.49: But all his acquaintances, including the women who had followed him from Galilee, stood at a distance, watching these things.	19.25: standing near the cross of Jesus were his mother, and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene .
