15.6	seven angels with the seven plagues, robed in <u>pure bright linen</u> [Ck, <i>li-non</i> ], with golden sashes across their chests.
18.12	cargo of gold, silver, jewels and pearls, fine linen [Gk, <i>bussinos</i> ], purple, silk and scarlet, all kinds of scented wood, all articles of ivory, all articles of costly wood, bronze, iron, and marble
18.16	"Alas, alas, the great city, clothed in fine linen [Gk, <i>bussinos</i> ], in purple and scarlet, adorned with gold, with jewels, and with pearls!"
19.8	to [the bride, New Jerusalem] it has been granted to be clothed with fine linen [Gk, <i>bussinos</i> ], bright and pure" for the <u>fine linen [Gk, <i>bussinos</i>] is</u> <u>the righteous deeds of the saints.</u>
19.14	And the armies of heaven, wearing <u>fine linen [Gk, <i>bussinos</i>], white and</u> <u>pure,</u> were following him on white horses.
