Luke 8.10	said, "To you it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom of God" (from Mark 4.11; also, Matt 13.11, not elsewhere in Gospels)
19 times in Paul	e.g.: When I came to you, brothers and sisters, I did not come proclaiming the mys- tery of God to you in lofty words or wisdom. (I Corinthians 2.1)
	Think of us in this way, as servants of Christ and stewards of God's mysteries. (1 Co- rinthians 4.1)
4 times in Revelation	e.g., "in the days when the seventh angel is to blow his trumpet, the mystery of God will be fulfilled, as he announced to his servants the prophets." (Revelation 10.7)
Daniel 2.18-19	told them to seek mercy from the God of heaven concerning this mystery, so that Daniel and his companions with the rest of the wise men of Babylon might not per- ish. Then the mystery was revealed to Daniel in a vision of the night, and Daniel blessed the God of heaven.

Colossians 2.2- 3	I want their hearts to be encouraged and united in love, so that they may have all the riches of assured understanding and have the knowledge of God's mystery, that is, Christ himself, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
Daniel 2.22	He reveals deep and hidden things
Sirach 14.21	He who reflects in his mind on [Wisdom's] ways will also ponder her secrets.
	KRUPTOS [17 TIMES IN NEW TESTAMENT; 19X IN THE LXX]
Luke 8.17	For nothing is hidden that will not be disclosed, nor is anything secret that will not become known and come to light. (from Mark 4.22; also, Matt 10.26)
Luke 12.2	Nothing is covered up that will not be uncovered, and nothing secret that will not become known.
Matthew 6.4, 6	"so that your alms may be done in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you.,,, But whenever you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you."

Sirach 4.18	Then [Wisdom] will come straight back to him and gladden him, and will reveal her secrets to him.
Wisdom 7.21- 22a	I learned both what is secret and what is manifest, for wisdom, the fashioner of all things, taught me.
