

Smoke [*kapnos*] in Revelation [only Acts 2.19 elsewhere in NT]

8.4	And the smoke of the incense , with the prayers of the saints, rose before God from the hand of the angel.
9.2	he opened the shaft of the bottomless pit, and from the shaft rose smoke like the smoke of a great furnace , and the sun and the air were darkened with the smoke from the shaft. (again, 9.3; cf. Exodus 19.18: “the smoke went up like the smoke of a kiln...”)
9.17	the heads of the horses were like lions' heads, and fire and smoke and sulfur came out of their mouths . (again, 9.18)
14.11	And the smoke of their [those who worship the beast, etc.] torment goes up forever and ever. (cf. Isaiah 34.10: “(Edom’s) smoke shall go up forever.”)
15.8	and the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from his power, and no one could enter the temple until the seven plagues of the seven angels were ended.
18.9	And the kings of the earth, who committed fornication and lived in luxury with her, will weep and wail over her when they see the smoke of [Babylon’s] burning (again, 18.9; 19.3)
