The Song of Moses, the Song of the Lamb: intertextual echoes

REVELATION 15.3-4 HEBREW SCRIPTURE ECHO

And they sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb: "Great and amazing are vour deeds, Lord God the Almighty! Just and true are your ways, King of the nations! Lord, who will not fear and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship before you, for your judgments have been revealed."

Exodus 14.31b:

So the people feared YHWH and believed in YHWH and in his servant Moses.

Psalm 86.8-10:

There is none like you among the gods, O Lord, nor are there any works like yours. All the nations you have made shall come and bow down before you, O Lord, and shall glorify your name. For you are great and do wondrous things; you alone are God.

Jeremiah 10.7:

Who would not fear you, O King of the nations? For that is your due; among all the wise ones of the nations and in all their kingdoms there is no one like you.

Deuteronomy 32.4:

The Rock, his work is perfect, and all his ways are just. A faithful God, without deceit, just and upright is he

Psalm 145.17:

YHWH is just in all his ways, and kind in all his doings.

Tobit 12.22:

So they confessed the great and wonderful works of God, andacknowledged that the angel of the Lord had appeared to them.

Amos 4.13 [also, 5.14, 15, 16, 27]:

For lo, the one who forms the mountains, creates the wind, reveals his thoughts to mortals, makes the morning darkness, and treads on the heights of the earth-- YHWH, the God of hosts, is his name!

Psalm 98.2:

The LORD has made known his victory; he has revealed his vindication in the sight of the nations.
