Some translations of Luke 7.29-30

KJ21

And all the people that heard Him, and the publicans, **justified God**, **being baptized with the baptism of John**. But the Pharisees and **lawyers rejected the counsel of God** against themselves, being not baptized by him.

CEB

Everyone who heard this, including the tax collectors, **acknowledged God's justice** because they had been baptized by John. But the Pharisees and legal experts rejected God's will for themselves because they hadn't been baptized by John.

NABRE

(All the people who listened, including the tax collectors, and who were baptized with the baptism of John, acknowledged the righteousness of God; but the Pharisees and scholars of the law, who were not baptized by him, rejected the plan of God for themselves.)

NIRV

All the people who heard Jesus' words **agreed that God's way was right**. Even the tax collectors agreed. **These people had all been baptized by John**. But the Pharisees and the **authorities on the law did not accept for themselves God's purpose**. So they had not been baptized by John.

NRSVCE

And all the people who heard this, including the tax collectors, **acknowledged the justice of God**, **because they had been baptized with John's baptism**. But by refusing to be baptized by him, the Pharisees and the **lawyers rejected God's purpose** for themselves.)

NRSVUE

And all the people who heard this, including the tax collectors, **acknowledged the justice of God, having been baptized with John's baptism.** But the Pharisees and the **experts in the law**, not having been baptized by him, **rejected God's purpose** for themselves.
