Wrath/fury/anger [orgē and thumou] in Revelation

6.16-17: "Fall on us and hide us from the face of the one seated on the throne and from the <u>wrath [orgē]</u> of the Lamb; for the great day of <u>their wrath [orgē]</u> has come, and who is able to stand?"

11.18: The nations raged, but <u>your wrath [orgē] has come</u>, and the time for judging the dead, for rewarding your servants, the prophets and saints and all who fear your name, both small and great, and for destroying those who destroy the earth."

12.12: But woe to the earth and the sea, for the <u>devil has come down to you with great wrath [thumon]</u>, because he knows that his time is short!"

14.8: Then another angel, a second, followed, saying, "Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great! She has made all nations drink of the <u>wine of the wrath [thumou]</u> of her fornication."

14.10: [Those who worship the beast and its image] will also drink the <u>wine of God's wrath [orgē]</u>, poured unmixed into the <u>cup of his anger [thumou]</u>, and they will be tormented with fire and sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.

14.19: So the angel swung his sickle over the earth and gathered the vintage of the earth, and he threw it into the great wine press of the <u>wrath [thumou] of God</u>.

15.1: Then I saw another portent in heaven, great and amazing: seven angels with seven plagues, which are the last, for with them the <u>wrath of [thumou] God</u> is ended.

15.7: Then one of the four living creatures gave the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the <u>wrath [thumou]</u> of God, who lives forever and ever

16.1: Then I heard a loud voice from the temple telling the seven angels, "Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the <u>wrath [thumou] of God."</u>

16.19: The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. God remembered great Babylon and gave her the wine-cup of the <u>fury [thumou] of his wrath [orgē]</u>.

18.3a: For all the nations have drunk of the <u>wine of the wrath [thumou] of her fornication</u>

19.15: From his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, and he will rule them with a rod of iron; he will tread the <u>wine press of the fury [thu-mou]</u> of the wrath [orgē] of God the Almighty.
