

Justice and judgment [and with “true”] in Revelation

6.10	they cried out with a loud voice, "Sovereign Lord, holy and true* , <u>how long will it be</u> before you judge [krinō] and avenge [ekdikeō] our blood on the inhabitants of the earth?"
11.18	The nations raged, but your wrath <u>has come</u> , and the time for judging [krinō] the dead, for rewarding your servants, the prophets and saints and all who fear your name, both small and great, and for destroying those who destroy the earth."
14.7	... <u>hour of his judgment</u> [krisis] <u>has come</u> ...
15.3	Just [dikaios] and true are your ways, King of the nations!
16.5-7	And I heard the angel of the waters say, "You are just [dikaios], O Holy One, who are and were, for you have judged [krinō] these things; because they shed the blood of saints and prophets, you have given them blood to drink. It is what they deserve!" And I heard the altar respond, "Yes, O Lord God, the Almighty, your judgments [krisis] are true and just! [dikaios]"
18.8	...mighty is the Lord God who judges [krinō] (Babylon).
18.10	For <u>in one hour</u> your judgment [krisis] <u>has come</u> .
18.20	Rejoice over her, O heaven, you saints and apostles and prophets! For God has given judgment [krinō, krima] for you against her."
19.2	for his judgments [krisis] are true and just [dikaios]; he has judged [krinō] the great whore who corrupted the earth with her fornication, and he has avenged [ekdikeō] on her the blood of his servants."
19.11	Its rider is called Faithful and True , and in justice [dikaiosunē] he judges [krinō] and makes war.
20.12	And the dead were judged [krinō] according to their works,
20.13	and all were judged [krinō] according to what they had done.
22.11	Let the unjust [adikeō] still do injustice [adikeō], and the filthy still be filthy, and the just [dikaios] still do justice [dikaiosunē], and the holy still be holy."
