## "Mother" and "Mary" (Jesus' mother) in Luke's Gospel

**BLUE/WHITE** = positive statements; **PINK** = critical statements

Luke 1-2	
1.27	The virgin's name was <b>Mary</b>
1.30	The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, <b>Mary</b>
1.34	Mary said to the angel
1.38	Then <b>Mary</b> said, "Here am I, the servant of the Lord"
1.39	In those days <b>Mary</b> set out and went with haste to a Judean town in the hill country
1.43	And why has this happened to me, that the <b>mother</b> of my Lord comes to me?
1.46	And <b>Mary</b> said, "My soul magnifies the Lord"

And he was told, "Your <b>mother</b> and your brothers are standing outside, wanting to see you." But he said to them, "My <b>mother</b> and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and do it."
11.27-	["mother" implied]
28	While he was saying this, a woman in the crowd raised her voice and said to him, "Blessed is the womb that bore you and the breasts that nursed you!" But he said, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it!"
12.52- 53	From now on five in one household will be divided, three against two and two against three; they will be divided: father against son and son against father, <b>mother</b> against daughter and daughter against <b>mother</b> , <b>mother</b> -in-law against her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against <b>mother</b> -in-law.
14.26	"Whoever comes to me and does not hate father and <b>mother</b> , wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and even life itself, cannot be my disciple."
18.20	Honor your father and <b>mother</b> .
21.16	[" <b>mother</b> " implied] You will be betrayed even by parents and brothers, by relatives and friends; and they will put some of you to death.
