## Other uses for comparison of context:

MATT 5.32: But I say to you that anyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of *porneia*, causes her to commit adultery (again, Matt 19.9)

**Acts 15.20:** we should write to them to abstain only from things polluted by idols and from *porneia* and from whatever has been strangled and from blood.

**1 CORINTHIANS 5.1:** It is actually reported that there is **porneia** among you, and of a kind that is not found even among pagans; for a man is living with his father's wife.

**JEREMIAH 3.6:** The LORD said to me in the days of King Josiah: Have you seen what she did, that faithless one, Israel, how she went up on every high hill and under every green tree, and **porneuo** there?

**EZEKIEL 16.15:** But you [Jerusalem] trusted in your beauty, and **porneuō** because of your fame, and lavished your *porneia* on any passer-by.

**2 Kings 9.22:** When Joram saw Jehu, he said, "Is it peace, Jehu?" He answered, "What peace can there be, so long as the many *porneia* and sorceries of your mother <u>Jezebel</u> continue?"
