Seeing (Hebrew, r'h) in 1 Samuel 16 (NRSV adapted to show the "see" uses")

EPISODE ONE	
16.1	I [YHWH] have seen for myself a king among his sons.
16.6	When they came, [Samuel] <u>saw</u> Eliab and thought, "Surely YHWH's anoint- ed is now before YHWH."
16.7	But YHWH said to Samuel, " Do not <u>see</u> his appearance or on the height of his stature, because I have rejected him; for YHWH does not <u>see</u> as mortals <u>see</u> ; they <u>see</u> the outward appearance, but YHWH sees the heart."
Episode two	
16.17	So Saul said to his servants, " Look for someone who can play well, and bring him to me."
16.18	One of the young men answered, " <u>I have seen</u> a son of Jesse the Bethle- hemite who is skillful in playing, a man of valor, a warrior, prudent in speech, and a man of good presence; and YHWH is with him."

Note also:

16.7	But YHWH said to Samuel, " Do not look [Hebrew, <i>nbt</i>] on his appearance or on the height of his stature
16.16	Let our lord now command the servants who attend you to look for [He- brew, <i>bqsh</i>] someone who is skillful in playing the lyre
