7.37: And a woman in the city	8.27: <b>a man of the city</b> who had demons met him.
7.38: (her hair is "improperly" dressed)	8.27: For a long time he had worn no clothes
7.38: She stood behind him <b>at his feet</b>	8.35: they found the man from whom the demons had gone sitting <b>at the feet of Jesus</b>
7.50: And he said to the woman, "Your faith <b>has saved you</b> "	8.36: the one who had been possessed by demons <b>had been saved</b> .
