

The “woman of the city” and the “man of the city” in Luke’s Gospel

7.37: And a woman in the city	8.27: a man of the city who had demons met him.
7.38: (her hair is “improperly” dressed)	8.27: For a long time he had worn no clothes
7.38: She stood behind him at his feet	8.35: they found the man from whom the demons had gone sitting at the feet of Jesus
7.50: And he said to the woman, “Your faith has saved you... ”	8.36: the one who had been possessed by demons had been saved.
