Genesis 15.12: the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram, and a

deep and terrifying darkness descended upon him.

1 Samuel 26.12: So David took the spear that was at Saul's head and the water jar.

and they went away. No one saw it, or knew it, nor did anyone awake; for they were all asleep, because **a deep sleep from**

YHWH had fallen upon them.

Isaiah 29.10: For YHWH has poured out upon you a spirit of deep sleep; he

has closed your eyes, you prophets, and covered your heads, you

seers.

Job 4.13-14, 16c-17: Amid thoughts from visions of the night, when deep sleep falls

on mortals, <u>dread came upon me, and trembling</u>, which made all my bones shake....there was silence, then I heard a voice: Can mortals be <u>righteous [tsedaq]</u> before God? Can human beings be

pure before their Maker?

Job 33.14-17: For God speaks in one way, and in two, though people do not per-

ceive it. In a dream, <u>in a vision</u> of the night, **when deep sleep falls on mortals,** while they slumber on their beds, then he opens their ears, and <u>terrifies them with warnings</u>, that he may turn

them aside from their deeds, and keep them from pride...

Proverbs 19.15: Laziness brings on deep sleep; an idle person will suffer hunger.
