

Genesis 15.1-6 and 15.7-21 key words

15.1-6

After these things the word of YHWH came to Abram in a vision, "Do not be afraid, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great." But Abram said, "O Lord YHWH, what **will you give** [nthn] me, for I continue childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?" And Abram said, "**You have given** [nthn] me no **offspring** [zera`], and so a slave born in my house is to be my **heir** [yoresh]." But the word of YHWH came to him, "This man shall not be your **heir** [yoresh]; no one but your very own **issue** [yts] shall be your **heir** [yoresh]." He **brought** [yts] him outside and said, "Look toward heaven and count the stars, if you are able to count them." Then he said to him, "So shall your **descendants** [zera`], be." And he believed YHWH; and YHWH reckoned it to him as righteousness.

[outcome: people coming from Abram]

15.7-21

Then he said to him, "I am YHWH who **brought you** [yts] from Ur of the Chaldeans, **to give you** [nthn] this land **to possess** [yoresh]" But he said, "O Lord YHWH, how am I to know that **I shall possess** [yoresh] it?" He said to him, "Bring me a heifer three years old, a female goat three years old, a ram three years old, a turtle-dove, and a young pigeon." He brought him all these and cut them in two, **laying** [nthn] each half over against the other; but he did not cut the birds in two. And when birds of prey came down on the carcasses, Abram drove them away. As the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram, and a deep and terrifying darkness descended upon him. Then YHWH said to Abram, "Know this for certain, that your **offspring** [zera`], shall be aliens in a land that is not theirs, and shall be slaves there, and they shall be oppressed for four hundred years; but I will bring judgment on the nation that they serve, and afterward **they shall come out** [yts] with great possessions. As for yourself, you shall go to your ancestors in peace; you shall be buried in a good old age. And they shall come back here in the fourth generation; for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet complete." When the sun had gone down and it was dark, a smoking fire pot and a flaming torch passed between these pieces. On that day YHWH made a covenant with Abram, saying, "To your **descendants** [zera`], **I give** [nthn] this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates, the land of the Kenites, the Kenizzites, the Kadmonites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Rephaim, the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Girgashites, and the Jebusites."
