## Range of meanings of Hebrew, chshv (translations from NRSV)

**LEVITICUS 27.23:** the priest **shall compute** for it the proportionate assessment up to the year of jubilee

**PSALM 32.2**: Happy are those to whom the LORD **imputes** [**plans?**] no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

PSALM 40.17: As for me, I am poor and needy, but the Lord takes thought for me.

**PSALM 106.31:** And that **has been reckoned** to [Phinehas] as righteousness from generation to generation forever. [referencing Numbers 25.7-8]

Genesis 38.15: When Judah saw her, he thought her to be a prostitute

**Genesis 50.20:** Even though **you intended** to do harm to me, God **intended** it for good

**1 Samuel 1.13:** Hannah was praying silently; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard; therefore Eli **thought** she was drunk.

**1 Maccabees 2.51-52:** Remember the deeds of the ancestors, which they did in their generations, and you will receive great honor and an everlasting name. Was not Abraham found faithful when tested, and **it was reckoned** to him as righteousness?
