Some issues to consider when reading the story of David and Goliath (1 Samuel 17)

- 1. **Textual:** The huge differences between the Hebrew (Masoretic Text [MT]) and the Greek (Septuagint [LXX]): MT contains over 20 verses not in LXX
- 2. **CULTURAL, MODERN:** The use in recent centuries of "Philistine" to describe uncultured or anti-intellectual people/attitudes
- 3. **CULTURAL, ANCIENT:** The many echoes of ancient Greek culture, including Goliath's array and the tradition of "single combat" to resolve international conflict (see *The Iliad*)
- 4. **Cultural, Ancient:** The incorrect equation of David's "sling" (Hebrew, *qela*`) with a modern "slingshot" (see Judges 20.16)
