

Biblical trope of birds eating corpses after war/destruction

1 Samuel 17.44	The Philistine said to David "Come to me and I will give your flesh to the birds of the air and to the wild animals of the field."
Psalms 79.2	They have given the bodies of your servants to the birds of the air for food the flesh of your faithful to the wild animals of the earth.
Jeremiah 16.4	They shall perish by the sword and by famine, and their dead bodies shall become food for the birds of the air and for the wild animals of the earth.
Jeremiah 19.7	I will give their dead bodies for food to the birds of the air and to the wild animals of the earth.
Ezekiel 32.4	I will cause all the birds of the air to settle on you, and I will let the wild animals of the whole earth gorge themselves with you.
Ezekiel 39.17-18	Speak to the birds of every kind and to all the wild animals: Assemble and come, gather from all around to the sacrificial feast that I am preparing for you, a great sacrificial feast on the mountains of Israel, and you shall eat flesh and drink blood. You shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth--of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bulls, all of them fatlings of Bashan.
Revelation 19.17-18	Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, and with a loud voice he called to all the birds that fly in midheaven, "Come, gather for the great supper of God, to eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of the mighty, the flesh of horses and their riders--flesh of all, both free and slave, both small and great."
