Chronological sequence in Revelation 19-20 if taken literally

- 1. The heavenly chorus sings, "Hallelujah!" (19.1-6)
- 2. The marriage of Lamb/bride "has come" (19.7-9) [But when does it actually take place?]
- 3. John falls at the feet of the angel (19.10)
- 4. Heaven opens and a white horse appears, with the "armies of heaven" following (19.11-16)
- 5. An angel calls to gather for the "great supper of God" (19.17-18) [Is this the same as "the wedding feast"?]
- 6. The beast, kings and armies gather to war against the rider and his army, but the beast and false prophet are captured and hurled into the lake of fire, while "the rest" are "killed" by "the sword that came from his mouth" (19.19-21)
- 7. An angel comes down from heaven with a key to the abyss and a chain, seizes the dragon, bound him for a thousand years, and threw up into the abyss. (20.1-3)
- 8. John sees thrones of authority and the beheaded witnesses to Jesus, who came to life and "reigned with Christ a thousand years," named as "the first resurrection" (20.4-6)
 - [Is the thousand year reign simultaneous with the thousand years of the dragon bound in the abyss?]
- 9. After the thousand years, Satan is released, deceives the nations into gathering for battle against "the camp of the saints and the beloved city" and are immediately consumed, and the devil is thrown into the lake of fire (20.7-10)
 - [Is "the beloved city" the same as New Jerusalem, which doesn't appear until chapter 21?]
- 10. John sees a "great white throne" with one seated on it, from which earth and heaven flee, then the dead are seen standing before the throne and the dead are judged according to their works recorded in books; Death and Hades are thrown into the lake of fire, named "the second death" (20.8-15)
