

## Echoes of Revelation's opening chapters in Rev 19-20

19.6: Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like <b>the sound of many waters</b>	1.15: his voice was like the <b>sound of many waters</b> .
19.9: <b>Write</b> this	[ <b>"write"</b> 9./13x in Rev in 1.11-3.14]
19.10: I am a fellow servant with you and your comrades who <b>hold the testimony of Jesus</b> . Worship God! For <b>the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy</b> .	1.2: [the angel] who testified to the word of God and to <b>the testimony of Jesus</b>  1.9: [ <b>I, John</b> ] was on the island called <b>Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus</b> .
19.11: Its rider is called <b>Faithful and True</b>	3.14: The words of the Amen, the <b>faithful and true</b> witness
19.12: <b>His eyes are like a flame of fire</b>	1.14: <b>his eyes were like a flame of fire</b>
19.12: <b>he has a name inscribed that no one knows but himself</b> .	2.17: on the white stone is written a new <b>name that no one knows except the one who receives it</b> .
19.15: 15 <b>From his mouth comes a sharp sword</b> with which to strike down the nations	1.16: and <b>from his mouth came a sharp, two-edged sword</b> [also, 2.12]
19.15: and <b>he will rule them with a rod of iron</b>	2.27: <b>to rule them with an iron rod</b>
20.1: <b>in his hand the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain</b>	1.18: <b>I have the keys of Death and of Hades</b> .
20.4: Then I saw <b>thrones</b> , and <b>those seated on them were given authority to judge</b> . I also saw the lives of those who had been beheaded for their testimony to Jesus and for the word of God.	3.21: <b>To the one who conquers I will give a place with me on my throne</b> , just as I myself conquered and sat down with my Father on his throne.
20.4: <b>They came to life</b> and reigned with Christ a thousand years.	1.18: <b>I was dead, and see, I am alive</b> forever and ever [also, 2.8]
20.6: <b>they will be priests of God and of Christ and they will reign with him a thousand years</b> .	1.6: <b>made us to be a kingdom, priests serving his God and Father</b>
20.6: Over these <b>the second death</b> has no power	2.11: Whoever conquers will not be harmed by <b>the second death</b> .
20.13-14: <b>Death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them</b> , and all were judged according to what they had done. Then <b>Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire</b> .	1.18: <b>I have the keys of Death and of Hades</b> .
