

## Hebrew Scripture echoes in Revelation 20

<p>20.2a: He <b>seized the dragon, that ancient serpent</b></p>	<p>Isaiah 27.1: On that day YHWH with his cruel and great and strong sword will punish <b>Leviathan the fleeing serpent</b>, Leviathan the twisting serpent, and he <b>will kill the dragon that is in the sea.</b></p>
<p>20.2b: and <b>bound him for a thousand years</b></p>	<p><i>1 Enoch 10.4:</i> : "<b>Bind Azazel hand and foot, and cast him into the darkness</b>"</p>
<p>20.6b: they will be priests of God and of Christ, and <b>they will reign with him a thousand years.</b></p>	<p><i>Jubilees 23:27-30:</i> "And the days shall begin to grow many and increase amongst those children of men <b>Till their days draw nigh to one thousand years ...</b> (v. 29) And all their days they shall complete and live in peace and in joy, <b>And there shall be no Satan nor any evil destroyer"</b></p>
<p>20.8: [Satan] will come out to deceive the nations <b>at the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog</b>, in order to gather them for battle...</p>	<p>Isaiah 11.12: He will raise a signal for the nations, and will assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather the dispersed of Judah from <b>the four corners of the earth.</b> Ezekiel 38.2: Mortal, set your face toward <b>Gog, of the land of Magog...</b></p>
<p>20.8: they are as <b>numerous as the sands of the sea.</b></p>	<p>Genesis 32.12: I will surely do you good, and <b>make your offspring as the sand of the sea...</b></p>
<p>20.9a: <b>They marched up over the breadth of the earth</b> and surrounded the camp of the saints and <b>the beloved city.</b></p>	<p>Habakkuk 1.6: I am rousing the Chaldeans, that fierce and impetuous nation, <b>who march through the breadth of the earth</b> to seize dwellings not their own. Sirach 24:11: In <b>the beloved city</b> likewise he gave me a resting place, and in Jerusalem was my dominion.</p>
<p>20.9b: And <b>fire came down from heaven and consumed them.</b></p>	<p>Genesis 19.24: Then <b>YHWH rained on Sodom and Gomorrah sulfur and fire from YHWH out of heaven</b> 2 Kings 1.10: But <b>Elijah</b> answered the captain of fifty, "If I am a man of God, <b>let fire come down from heaven and consume you and your fifty.</b>" Then fire came down from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.</p>
<p>20.10: And the <b>devil</b> who had deceived them <b>was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur</b></p>	<p><i>1 Enoch 10:7:</i> "<b>And on the day of the great judgement he [Azazel] shall be cast into the fire.</b>"</p>

<p>20.11b: <b>the earth and the heaven fled from his presence</b></p>	<p>Isaiah 51.6: Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look at the earth beneath; for <b>the heavens will vanish like smoke, the earth will wear out like a garment</b>, and those who live on it will die like gnats; but my salvation will be forever, and my deliverance will never be ended.</p>
<p>20.11c: and <b>no place was found for them.</b></p>	<p>Daniel 2.35 (LXX, Theodosian version): Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold, were all broken in pieces and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away, and <b>no place was found for them.</b></p>
<p>20.12: And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and <b>books were opened.</b></p>	<p>Daniel 7.10: The court sat in judgment, and the <b>books were opened.</b>  <i>4 Ezra</i> 6.20: when the seal is placed upon the age which is about to pass away, then I will show these signs: <b>the books shall be opened</b> before the firmament, and all shall see it together  <i>1 Enoch</i> 47.3: In those days I saw the <b>Head of Days when He seated himself upon the throne of His glory, and the books of the living were opened before Him</b></p>
<p>20.13: And the <b>sea gave up the dead that were in it, Death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them</b>, and all were judged according to what they had done.</p>	<p><i>1 Enoch</i> 51.1: And in those days shall the <b>earth also give back that which has been entrusted to it, and Sheol also shall give back that which it has received.</b> And hell shall give back that which it owes.</p>
