

## “Do not be afraid” in Luke’s Gospel

1.13	But the angel said to him, " <b>Do not be afraid, Zechariah</b> , for your prayer has been heard.
1.30	The angel said to her, " <b>Do not be afraid, Mary</b> , for you have found favor with God."
2.10	But the angel said <b>to [the shepherds]</b> , " <b>Do not be afraid</b> ; for see--I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people..."
5.10	Then Jesus said <b>to Simon</b> , " <b>Do not be afraid</b> ; from now on you will be catching people."
8.50	When Jesus heard this, he replied <b>[to the people in Jairus's house]</b> , " <b>Do not fear</b> . Only believe, and she will be saved."
12.4-5	"I tell you, <b>my friends, do not fear</b> those who kill the body, and after that can do nothing more. But I will warn you whom to fear: fear him who, after he has killed, has authority to cast into hell. Yes, I tell you, fear him!"
12.7	<b>Do not be afraid</b> ; you are of more value than many sparrows.
12.32	" <b>Do not be afraid, little flock</b> , for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom."
