

Luke 9: Discipleship and Christology

9.1-6: Giving “the twelve” “power and authority; preparing them to be sent to evangelize and heal

9.7-9: Herod wonders who Jesus is

9.10-17: a hungry crowd needs to be fed;
disciples’ response: “send the crowd away”

9.18-22: Who do the disciples know Jesus to be?

9.23-27: Picking up the cross, daily

9.28-36: Jesus’ transfiguration:
disciples’ response: “not knowing what to say”

9.37-43: A man with a child with a convulsive spirit begs Jesus to help;
disciples’ response: can’t do it

9.44-45: Jesus’ second “passion portent”;
disciples’ response: did not understand

9.46-48: The disciples argue about which of them is the greatest

9.49-50: Someone is casting out demons in Jesus’ name;
disciples’ response: try to stop him
