## Abram/Abraham age references in Genesis

12.4: So Abram went, as YHWH had told him; and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old
16.3: So, after Abram had lived ten years in the land of Canaan [= 85], Sarai, Abram's wife, took Hagar the Egyptian, her slave-girl, and gave her to her husband Abram as a woman.
16.16: Abram was eighty-six years old when Hagar bore him Ishmael.
17.1: When Abram was ninety-nine years old, YHWH appeared to Abram, and said to him, "I am God Almighty; walk before me, and be blameless.
17.17: Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed, and said to himself, "Can a child be born to a man who is a hundred years old?
17.24: Abraham was ninety-nine years old when he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin.
21.5: Abraham was a hundred years old when his son Isaac was born to him.
25.7: This is the length of Abraham's life, one hundred seventy-five years.
