# "Establishing [Hebrew, kon] the kingdom" in the David story

#### 1 SAMUEL 13.13-14

<u>Samuel said to Saul</u>, "You have done foolishly; you have not kept the commandment of YHWH your God, which he commanded you. **YHWH would have established your kingdom over Israel forever,** but **now your kingdom will not continue**; YHWH has sought out a man after his own heart; and YHWH has appointed him to be ruler over his people, because you have not kept what YHWH commanded you."

# **1 SAMUEL 20.31**

[Saul said to Jonathan] "For as long as the son of Jesse lives upon the earth, **neither** you nor your kingdom shall be established."

#### 2 SAMUEL 5.11-12

<u>King Hiram of Tyre sent messengers to David</u>, along with cedar trees, and carpenters and masons who built David a house. **David then perceived that YHWH had established him king over Israel**, and that he had exalted his kingdom for the sake of his people Israel.

# 2 SAMUEL 7.12-16

[Nathan quoting YHWH to David] When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come forth from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me. When he commits iniquity, I will punish him with a rod such as mortals use, with blows inflicted by human beings. But I will not take my steadfast love from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you. Your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me; your throne shall be established forever.

### 1 Kings 2.12

So **Solomon** sat on the throne of his father David; and his **kingdom was firmly established.** 

#### 1 Kings 2.24

[Solomon to Bathsheba] Now therefore as YHWH lives, who has established me and placed me on the throne of my father David, and who has made me a house as he promised, today Adonijah shall be put to death."

# 1 Kings 2.44-45

The <u>king [Solomon] also said to Shimei</u>, "You know in your own heart all the evil that you did to my father David; so YHWH will bring back your evil on your own head. But **King Solomon shall be blessed, and the throne of David shall be established before YHWH forever**."
