Parental tension over half-brother and brother	Genesis 21.9-11 [Isaac/Ish-mael, firstborn]	2 Samuel 14 [Absalom/Am- non, firstborn, echoing Cain/Abel]
Aftermath: alienation from family/community	Genesis 22.19 [Abraham alienated from Sarah and Isaac]	2 Samuel 19.5ff [David alien- ated from army and all the tribes of Israel]
