

## “Generation(s)” [genea] in Luke’s Gospel

1.48, 50	Surely, from now on <b>all generations</b> will call me blessed... His mercy is for those who fear him from <b>generation to generation</b> .
7.31-32	"To what then will I compare the people of <b>this generation</b> , and what are they like? They are <u>like children sitting in the marketplace</u> and calling to one another, 'We played the flute for you, and you did not dance; we wailed, and you did not weep.'
11.29-32	When the crowds were increasing, he began to say, " <b>This generation</b> is an <u>evil generation; it asks for a sign</u> , but no sign will be given to it except the sign of Jonah. For just as Jonah became a sign to the people of Nineveh, so the Human One will be to <b>this generation</b> . The <u>queen of the South will rise at the judgment</u> with the people <b>of this generation</b> and <u>condemn</u> them, because she came from the ends of the earth to listen to the wisdom of Solomon, and see, something greater than Solomon is here! The <u>people of Nineveh will rise up at the judgment</u> with <b>this generation</b> and <u>condemn it</u> , because they repented at the proclamation of Jonah, and see, something greater than Jonah is here!
11.49-50	Therefore also the Wisdom of God said, 'I will send them prophets and apostles, some of whom they will kill and persecute,' so that <b>this generation</b> may be charged with the blood of all the prophets shed since the foundation of the world...
16.8	And his master commended the dishonest manager because he had acted shrewdly; for <u>the children of this age are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation</u> than are the children of light.
17.25	But first [the Human One] must <u>endure much suffering and be rejected by this generation</u> .
21.32	Truly I tell you, <b>this generation</b> will not pass away until all things have taken place.
<b>Two uses of “this generation” in the Septuagint</b>	
Genesis 7.1	Then YHWH said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and all your household, for I have seen that <u>you alone are righteous before me in this generation</u> .
Psalms 11.8 (Eng, 12.7)	You, O YHWH, will protect us; you will guard [ <i>phulassō</i> ] us from <b>this generation</b> forever.
